



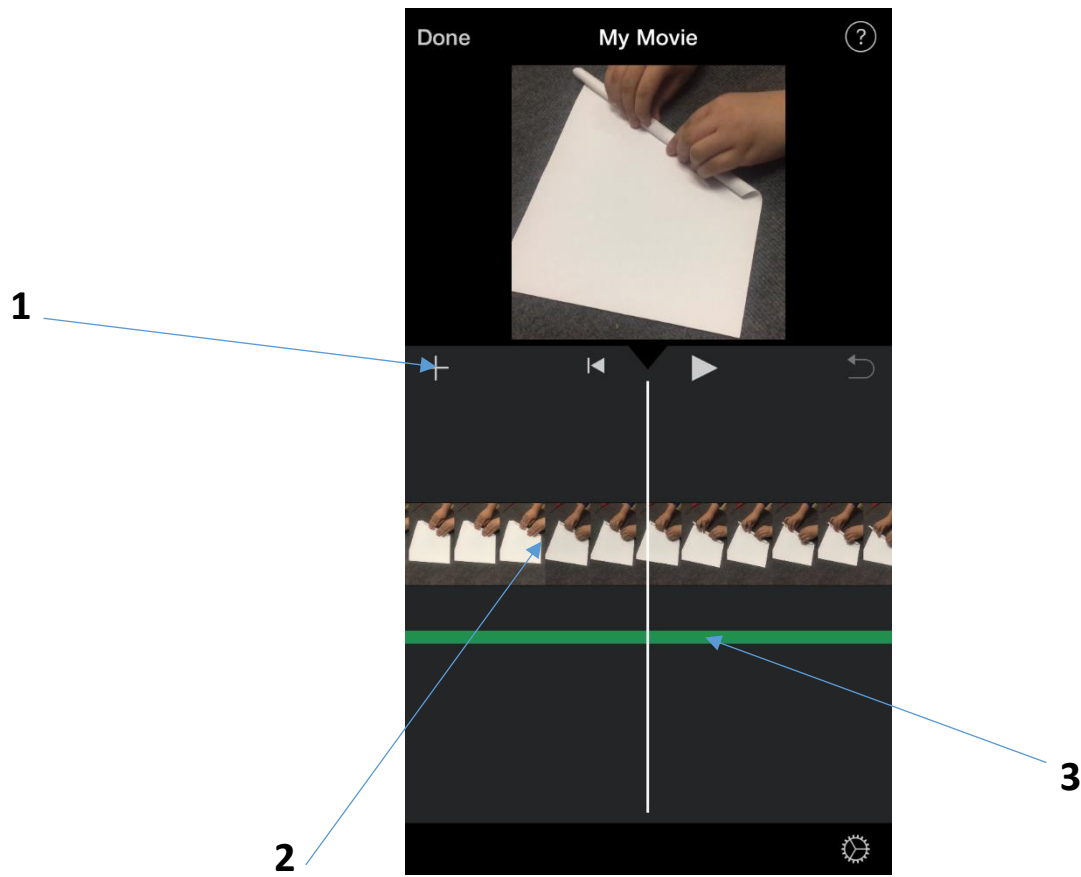


	Art Terms	
1	Line	The path created by a point moving through space.
2	Shape	An element of art defined as a two-dimensional enclosed space with boundaries defined by other elements of art (line, value, color, etc.).
3	Form	A three-dimensional object that encloses volume. It has a height, width, and depth.
4	Texture	The way that something looks like it would feel.
5	Shadow	A dark area or shape produced by a body coming between rays of light and a surface.
	Photoshop Terms	
6	Paint bucket	Fills an area of similar color with your Foreground color or a pattern
7	Rectangular Marquee	Draws rectangular selection outlines 
8	Opacity	the condition of lacking transparency or translucence
9	Flatten Layers	when you reduce all Photoshop layers to one background layer
10	Filters	individual algorithms (e.g. behind-the-scenes calculations) that alter the appearance of an image.
11	Crop Tool	Crop an image and remove unwanted areas 
12	Quick Selection	lets you easily select an object simply by painting over it with a brush 
13	Background Eraser	Erases areas of similar color in an image by painting over them. 
14	Layers	like sheets of stacked acetate. You can see through transparent areas of a layer to the layers below
16	Rotate	To change the orientation of a selection, a layer, or an entire image
17	Flip	an image horizontally produces a mirror image that helps you reverse the text in the image as if you were looking through a mirror.
	Film Terms	
18	Actor	a participant in an action or process.
19	Videographer	a person who makes video films.
20	Editing	the activity of selecting the scenes to be shown and putting them together to create a film

21	Voiceover	Narration or dialogue, as in a movie, commercial, or documentary, spoken by an unseen narrator or an onscreen character not seen speaking
22	Timing	The regulation of occurrence, pace, or coordination to achieve a desired effect, as in music or the theater.
23	B roll	supplemental or alternative footage intercut with the main shot.
24	Script	A copy of a text used by a director or performer.
